The match headlined Summerslam, was the second main event at Wrestlemania XXIX and headlined Extreme Rules. That REALLY should be something memorable but there's just nothing there. I remember Brock vs. Big Show better than I remember the HHH feud, and I literally couldn't remember Brock vs. Big Show two days after it happened.
