Above all else, this story is simple and you could follow it step by step along the way. It's a bit like Bret vs. Owen from 1994 and that's a high compliment.

I'll go with AJ winning for what should be obvious reasons. As is the case with every major Jericho match, there's no reason for him to win and I can't imagine WWE or Jericho in general for that matter is going to think otherwise. Styles wins here and moves on to something else, hopefully involving a title. Jericho can feud with whomever he wants and give them a good rub, despite the fact that he loses here.
