I've discovered these guys while I'm down in the Big Easy and I'm sold for life: Parkingpanda.com.

It's a simple idea: order parking permits in advance. Down here for Wrestlemania and Raw, it's \$15 to park per show, cash only. Parkingpanda listed a TON of parking areas within half a mile of the show, with some far under the cost. I got a pass for each show for \$4.50 each and THEY WORKED. I found the parking lot, walked maybe ten minutes and was at the Super Dome. No issues, no waiting in line (it was a good sized lot but very few cars as the regular price is higher than the site's price), easy to get in and out of, it was great.

They're available in most major cities with passes available for most major sports teams and arenas. Check them out.
